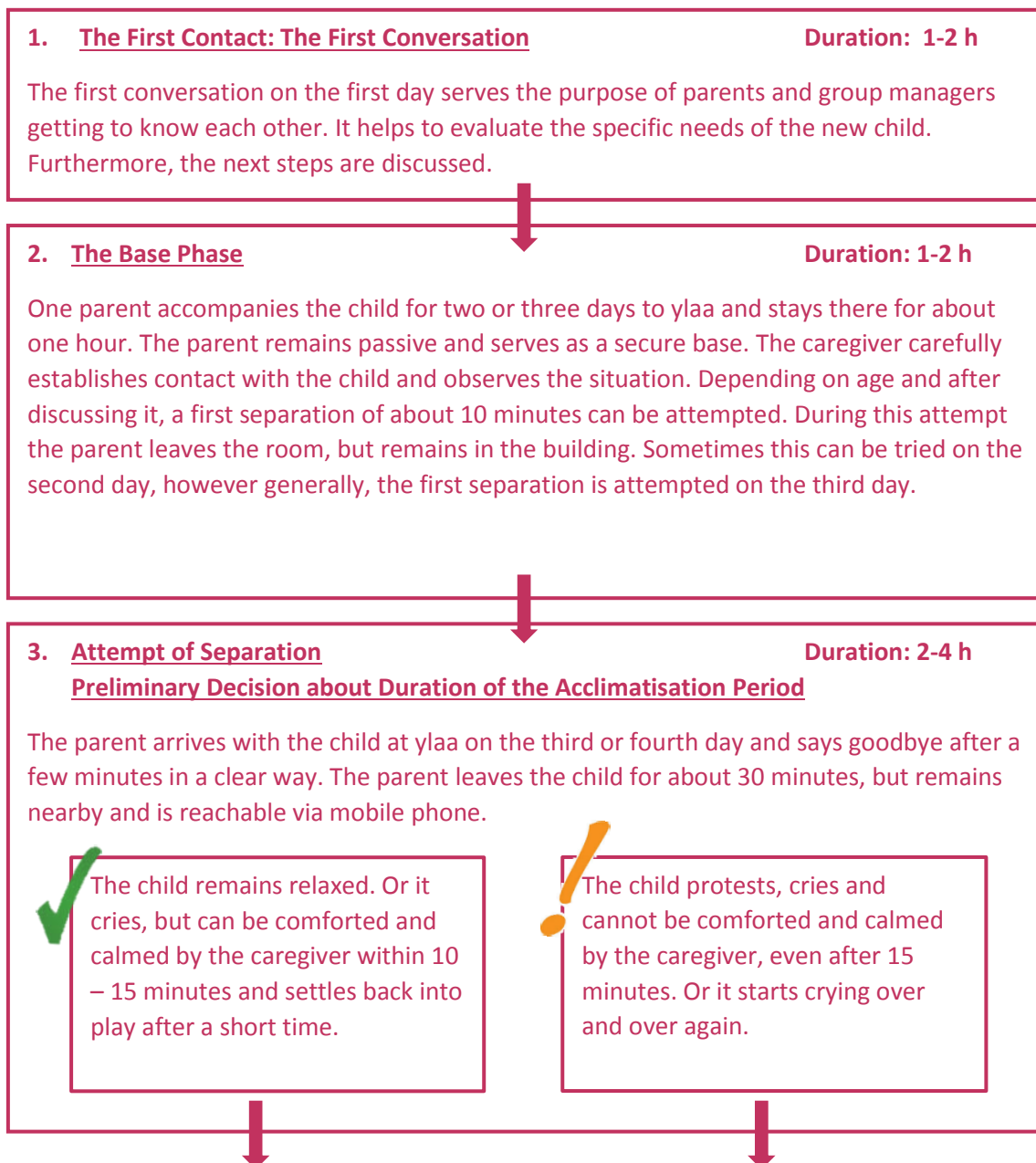


## Leaflet Acclimatisation at ytaa

### Targets:

- The child slowly gets used to the new caregivers and structures.
- The child becomes securely attached to the new caregiver and feels sheltered at ytaa.
- The acclimatisation builds up trust between parents and caregivers, it fosters a good cooperation with the parents, creates transparency and openness.
- The parents get used to being separated from their child.



#### 4. Stabilisation Phase



##### **Shorter Acclimatisation Period**

Day 4 to 5: Slow expansion of the separation time, first possible participation at meals and diaper changing, observation of the child's reactions; parent leaves ytaa.



##### **Longer Acclimatisation Period**

Day 4 to 5: Stabilisation of the relationship between child and caregiver; renewed attempt of separation on about the sixth day; depending on the child's reaction expansion of the separation time or of the acclimatization period.



#### 5. End Phase

The parent is no longer at ytaa but is available on mobile phone at all times. The acclimatisation period is finished, when the child can be comforted by the caregiver quickly and generally plays in a good mood.
